

INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

As parents we understand your concerns about your child's safety during their stay at the Rhode Island Volleyball Camp. We have taken precautions to ensure their safety. Camper Rules have been designed and are strictly enforced. These rules include: No drinking of alcohol, no drugs, and no smoking. Campers must walk in groups of 3 or more to the gym, the dining hall, back to the dormitory, to all activities & to the Emporium (Before the Evening Tournament ONLY). Campers are not allowed to leave the dorm after the evening activity. Campers must attend every meal, session and activity. Campers are kept busy from early morning until late at night. Campers are under the supervision of their court coaches during the day and at night in the dormitories by the entire staff. A strict curfew is also enforced.

The following are numbers you may need to get in touch with your daughter in case of an emergency. You may leave a message on the camp line, however if it is necessary for you to contact your child immediately, we suggest you use the numbers other than the dormitory. If you want to call your daughter in the dorm we suggest you take down the number of the nearest pay phone to your daughter's room at check-in. You should keep a record of the room number your daughter is in so that you can tell the individual who answers the phone where to find them. Please keep in mind it is easier for your daughter to call you.

We do not encourage campers to leave while camp is in session, however, if it is necessary for a camper to leave during camp, we ask that you fax/mail us the same information as above and include the reason for the departure and the date & time the camper will be returning to camp.
